Water Rate Changes



Effective July 1, 2013 water rates will change for the Village of Port Williams Water Utility. This means that on your next quarterly Water Utility bill in September, you will see a change in your rates for both base charges on water meters and usage per cubic meter.

The Utility and Review Board approved changes on June 21, 2013, to be effective the first of July 2013 and to change again on the first of April 2014 and 2015 in accordance with the decision of the Utility and Review Board Schedules A, B and C.

5/8"	\$60.78
3/4"	\$89.75
1"	\$147.69
1.5"	\$292.53
2"	\$466.35
3"	\$929.85
4"	\$1,451.29
6"	\$2,899.73

To find the size of your meter please refer to your water bill.

New Consumption Rate for Water Used Per Cubic Meter:

For all consumption the rate will decrease to - \$0.72

*Please note, these new rates will take effect on July 1, 2013 and will reflect on your next water bill in September, 2013.
